In 1987 I moved from Lübeck, Germany to Denver, Colorado and joined Centennial SchH Club. Besides being an active club member, I have served in various positions such as Chief of Judges, KG President, Regional and National Training Director and others in Germany as well as here in the US.

In my professional life I am a Mathematician and work currently as a Senior Systems Architect for CenturyLink in Denver, Colorado. My main hobby is, of course, dogs but my wife Faye and I also enjoy skiing, playing cards, or just a glass of wine with good friends.

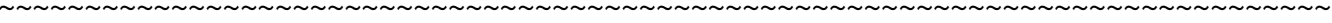
